This week, our Year 3 and 5 students have commenced their NAPLAN testing. They participate in national testing in the areas of Writing, Reading, Conventions of Language and Numeracy. All the tests are online (except for Year 3 Writing). As a school we look at the results from these tests, along with many other forms of assessment such as PAT, DIBELs, IntiaLit, SpellEx and classroom assessment. NAPLAN results give us opportunities to see trends in our student learning and plan for teaching in the future. The results should be available to parents by the start of term 3.

A reminder that we have our Annual General Meeting of the School Board next Wednesday evening (19th March) at 6.30pm, in our school library. The annual performance report will be available on our website after this meeting. Thank you to the parents who have dedicated their time to being on our current board and for those who are nominated to join.

I look forward to seeing you at our important learning conversations next week. These are an important part of the partnership between school and home to support your child's learning and wellbeing.

Over the past seven weeks, our preschool has been buzzing with engaging learning experiences. We have been exploring and connecting children's learning to cultural festivals celebrated in our wider community. By recognising and participating in these celebrations, our preschoolers gain valuable opportunities to develop a deeper understanding of community participation, inclusiveness, and respect for diversity. These experiences foster a strong sense of belonging for all children and families within our preschool.

This Friday we are celebrating the colourful festival Holi; this is a two-day festival, and it is celebrated with great joy in India and other countries in March.
