

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

This week is the Thirteenth Week in Ordinary Time and we celebrate the combined Feast of Saints Peter and Paul. Saints Peter and Paul were largely responsible for the foundation and early growth of the Church. Peter, a humble fisherman, was called by Jesus to be the "rock" on which the Church would be built (Matthew 16:13-19) becoming the first Pope. Paul on the other hand probably never met Jesus but travelled far and wide, established many new Christian communities and his writings make up much of the New Testament. Both saints encourage us to 'serve each other with whatever gifts we have received.' (1 Peter 4:10)


