

Visiting the Adelaide Botanic Gardens

Little Sprouts Program

During weeks 9 and 10 last term, the Preschool children visited the Adelaide Botanic Gardens to participate in the Little Sprouts program. Our excursion was an excellent opportunity for children to connect with nature using all their senses to explore. Walking through the gardens, we marvelled at mother nature's beauty - the big, tall trees, colourful flowers, peaceful pond with ducks, blossoming trees and much more. We were also lucky to see Chihuly's very artistic garden sculptures scattered throughout the garden.

After lunch, we headed to the Little Sprouts Kitchen Garden. Our facilitators divided us into three groups:

- One group explored the different plants, flowers and veggies used for cooking and eating.
- Another group observed some worms and even got the chance to touch them.
- The other group planted some snap pea seeds.

The children had the opportunity to do all three activities. They used all their senses in this experience: they could smell the fennel and orange plants/trees, taste some broccoli, observe and touch wriggly worms, and hear the busy buzzing bees. This exploration is also connected with our spring investigations, where we've seen a lot of blossoming and growing plants, flowers, and vegetables.























Yoga & Mindfulness




Yoga and Mindfulness continues this term. We continue with yoga poses and breath work.
