Transition to 2025

We have been welcoming many new faces to our community over the past few weeks during our transition visits.

In Week 9, we will have our whole school transition where your child meets their new class and teacher for 2025. I'd like to remind you of the complex process that is involved in class placements. All students are given an opportunity for input into their placement, these are taken into consideration. Parents were given the opportunity in term 3 to share any learning or other needs that we may not have been aware of. Each year teachers spend a great deal of time looking at class placements for the following year. This process takes many things into account. First and foremost, we take into consideration the learning needs of *all students*. We aim to ensure classes are 'balanced', by also taking into consideration a balance of gender, progress and levels of children's learning, children with specific needs (social/emotional, learning and physical), relationships and family considerations. Positive conversations about transitions are vital to assist your child build resilience and face new challenges.

Remember, your child's best support may be someone they have not yet met!

This week we welcomed the Premier, Mr Peter Malinauskas and the Hon Minister Blair Boyer along with Dr Neil McGoran (Executive Director of Catholic Education SA), Mr John Neate (Chair of the South Australian Commission for Catholic Schools), Fr Dean Marin (Vicar General) to officially open and bless our outdoor learning facilities. Dear Parents and Caregivers,

This weekend, the Church celebrates the first Sunday of the Season of Advent. The Season of Advent signifies the start of

a new Liturgical Year in the life of the Church. We enter into Year C and the focus for our Masses and Liturgies shifts from Year B and the Gospel of Mark, to Year C and a focus on the Gospel of Luke.

In our learning spaces, the liturgical colour changes from green (displayed during Ordinary Time) to purple which means we are entering into a time of preparation. The Nativity of the Holy Family will be displayed as well as the Advent Wreath. Each week in preparation for the Birth of Christ a new candle is lit. The first candle (purple) is the candle of hope. The second candle (purple) is the candle of peace. The third candle (rose) is the candle of love. The fourth candle (purple) is the candle of joy.

The Season of Advent begins on Sunday 1 December and ends on Tuesday 24 December.

THE HON PETER MALINAUSKAS MP

PREMIER OF SOUTH AUSTRALIA

Dear parent/caregiver

Today, the Federal Parliament passed laws to implement 16 years as the minimum age for access to social media.

This globally-leading reform was initiated here in South Australia.

The State Government was determined to see reform in this area amid mounting concern and recognition from experts, clinicians, educators, parents and caregivers of the negative impacts of social media use on children's mental health, wellbeing and development.

Following substantial engagement with these stakeholders, it became clear to us that, on balance, a national minimum age for access to social media, is the right thing to do.

That's why here in South Australia, we commissioned former Chief Justice of the High Court, the Hon. Robert French AC, to conduct an independent legal examination into enforcing a minimum age limit for social media access.

His report outlined a path forward to legislate; however, our preference was always for a nationally consistent law, which is why I raised the matter at National Cabinet.

Now, through the work we started here in South Australia, our nation will be a global leader in keeping our next generation safe from the harms of social media.

When we see products doing children harm, whether it be drugs, cigarettes or alcohol, governments have a role to play. The addictive nature of social media is no different.

The national laws will commence following a 12-month implementation period and will establish a minimum age for platforms like Facebook, Snapchat, TikTok and Instagram. They will place the onus on social media platforms – not parents or young people – to take reasonable steps to keep kids under 16 years of age off their platforms.

In 2019, we announced that in Government, we would pursue a full mobile phone ban for students in South Australian Government schools. We've seen strong and positive outcomes from this pursuit and now every other state has implemented a similar ban.

From next year, all students in state government and Catholic schools will be taught about online safety and the dangers of social media through a strengthened curriculum, providing the tools to navigate the online world confidently and safely.

The new social media laws are another step in ensuring our kids live healthy, active lives – and that smartphones and social media are not the defining feature of their childhood.

We are proud that South Australia has led the way on this important reform that will ensure our children and young people are protected and well-equipped for the world they are growing up in.
